

We served 211 students last year, with 31 GED Graduates, 101 in the Educational Program, and 110 students took a GED test in the computer lab. 90% of all students enrolled increased their grade levels one grade level or more. Many students continued to work over the summer in their books or in the online program and are coming in to complete the program.

What is the GED?

- \bullet High ${\bf School}$ ${\bf Equivalency}:$ The GED serves as a high school diploma equivalent.
- \bullet Four Subjects: It covers Math, Reading/Writing, Science, and Social Studies.
- Minimum **Passing Score:** You need a score of **145** out of 200 on each section to pass.
- Computer-Based: The test is administered on a computer.
- Accepted **Nationwide**: It's recognized by most colleges and employers in the U.S. and beyond.
- Available in Multiple Languages: The GED is offered in English, Spanish, and French.
- Minimum Age Requirement: You usually must be at least 16 years old to take the test (varies by state or country).
